Allan Soares and Lynda Dyer, co-founder of the Allyn fund, have established a scholarship fund to assist with the up-skilling of economically disadvantaged female students in years 2-4. The objective is to enable these women to improve their economic prospects by acquiring workforce ready skills alongside their graduate studies.
