A third-year Computer Science Engineering student, has had an engaging month marked by leadership and creativity. She successfully organized a meet-up for the Allyn girls, attended

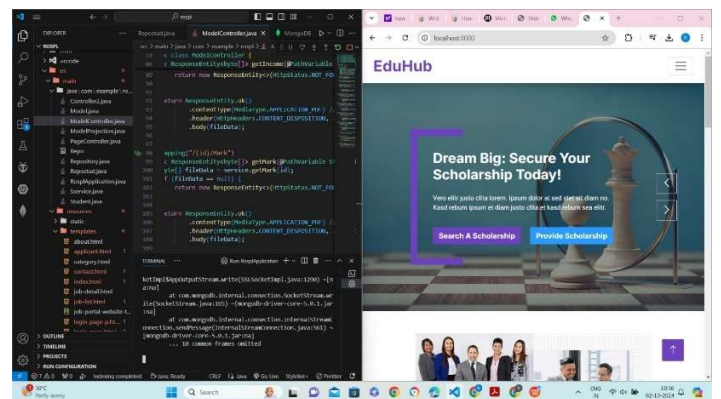
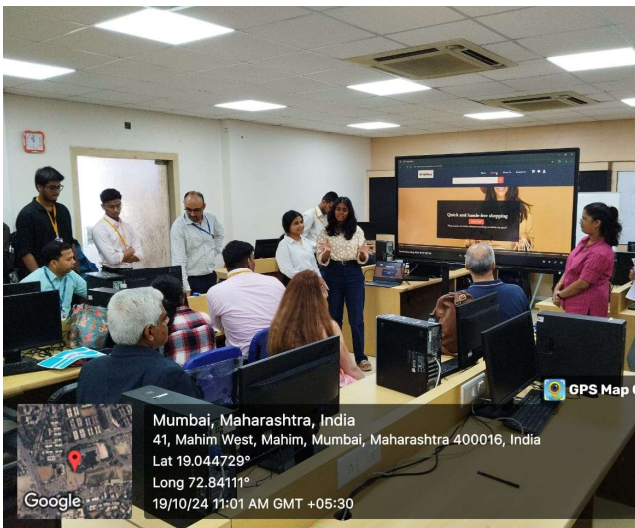

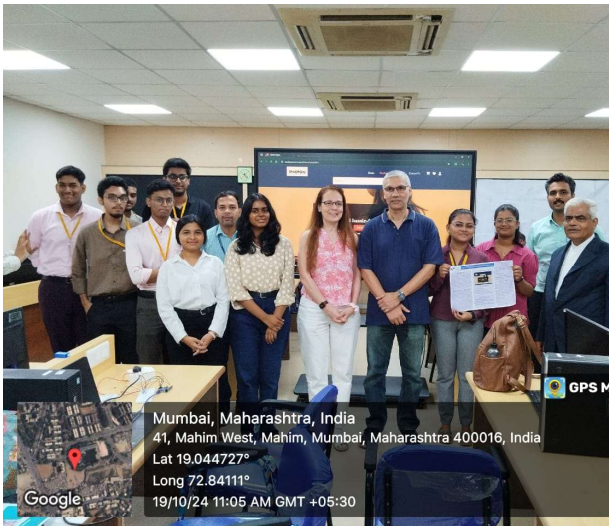
Riya Kamble (BEIT)

Allison Maegan Suvarna

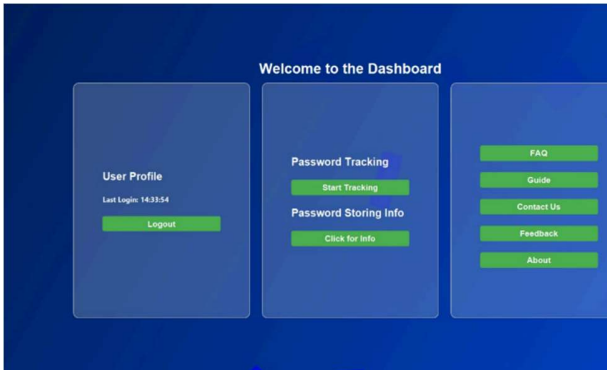
