She has completed her B.Tech in Aerospace Engineering. Currently, she works as a Quality Assurance Engineer and a Consultant by profession. She has been helping individuals, teams, startups and companies manifest their dreams.

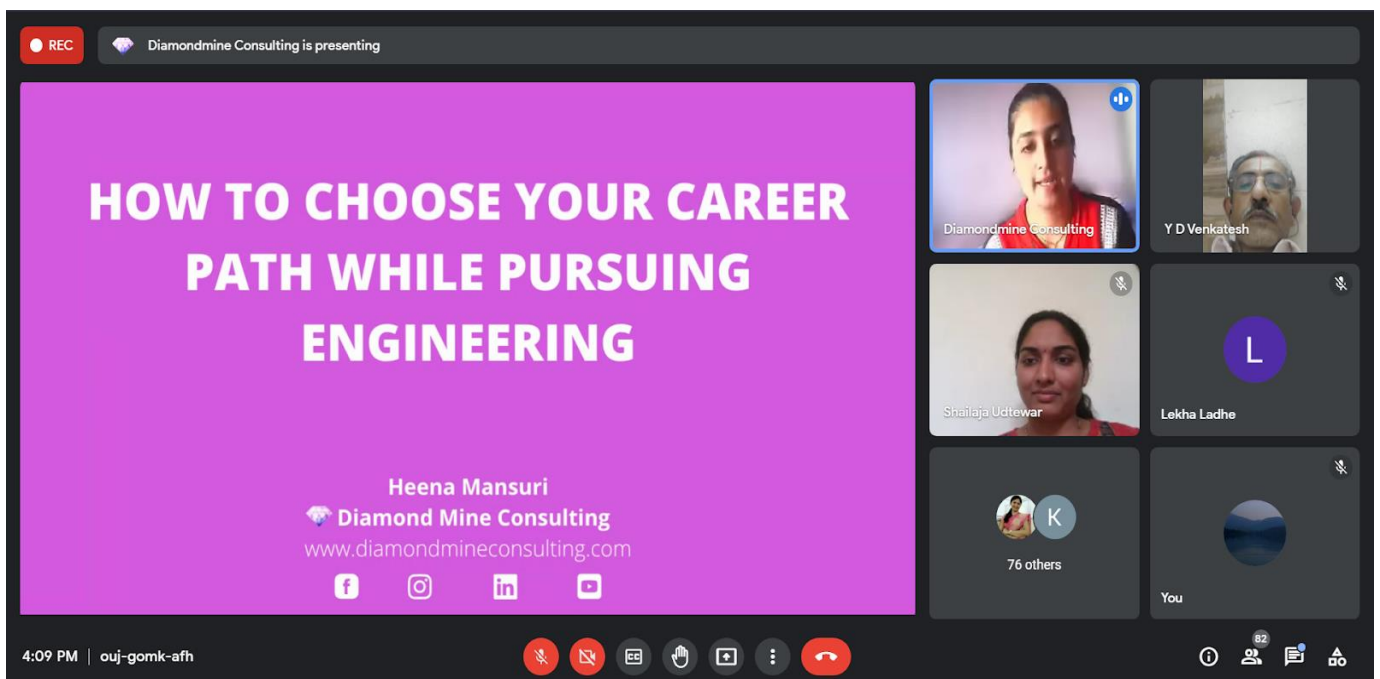

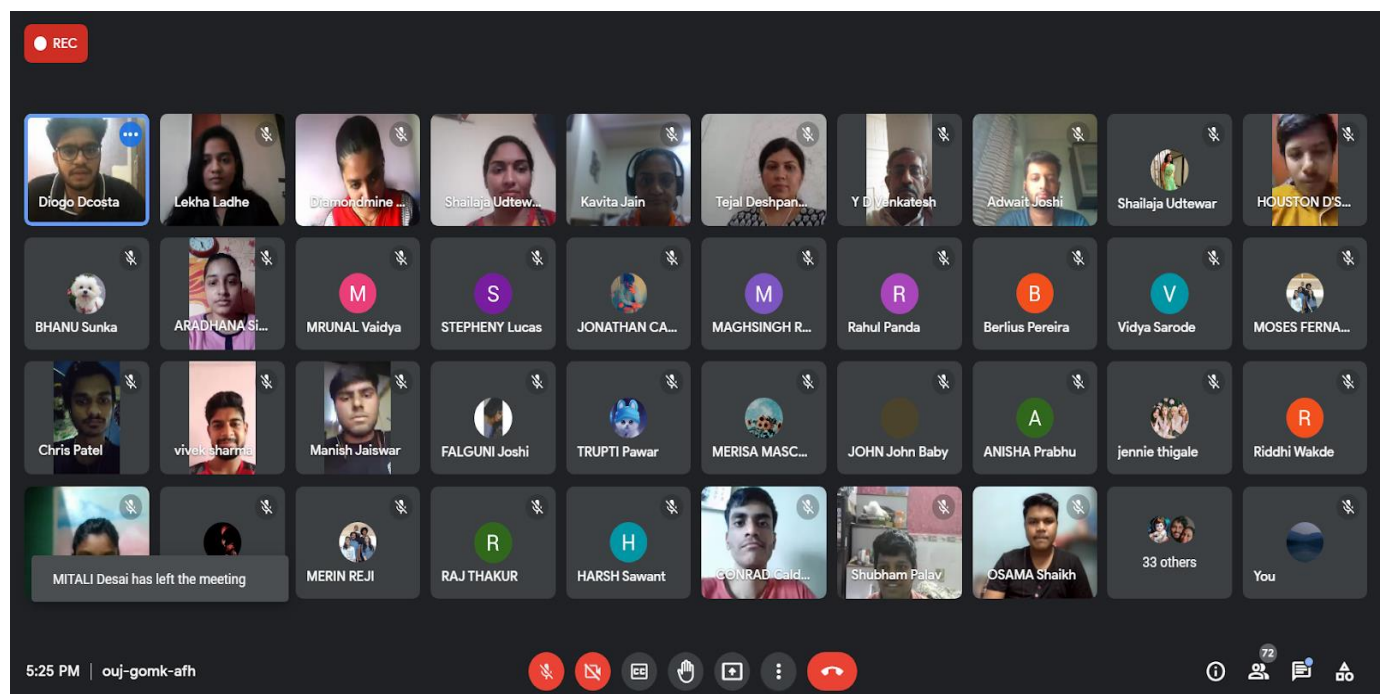
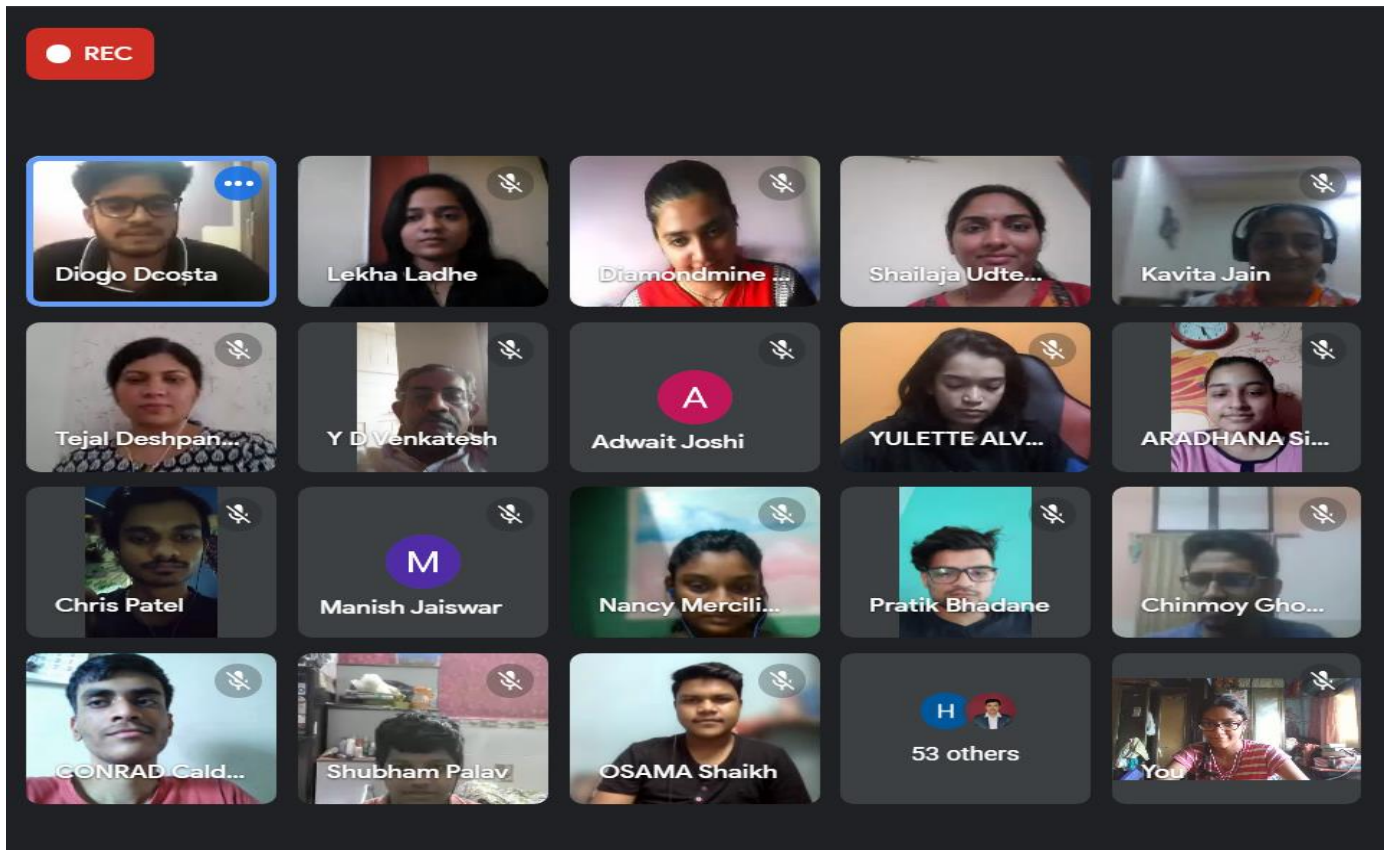
