Best poster was presented by Ms. Cecilia Dinesh from CE branch. She depicted the best rain water harvesting technology through the poster in a 3D form. She was awarded a cash prize of Rs. 2000/-.


Overall, it was a successful event organized by the Applied Science and Humanities department under IIC.
