2. **Placement Analysis – AY 2022 – 23:** The following Placement analysis table was shared with the IQAC Head by Training and Placement officer, Mr. Naveen Kukreja.

In this table, only the number of students placed in the companies and the total number of students present in B. E. were mentioned. Principal Sir asked Mr. Naveen to share the list of those students aspiring for higher studies.

Mr. Mahesh Pinge asked Mr. Naveen to enlighten upon the different strategies the Institute follows to improve the Marketability for students. To improve the number of placements, the students should be given soft skill training or there should be an implementation of value added courses that can be shown as a mean of improving students' technical and communication skills.

Prof. Pinge asked him why few students are rejected in the interview. There should be a feedback mechanism at the time of placement interview only. Whatever verbal inputs are given by the



representatives from the companies should be noted down then and there itself and accordingly, improvisation is expected.


Principal Sir said that, in order to improve on the statistics on placements, some departmental activities should be conducted for the weak students. Mr. Naveen should work in collaboration with all the three Departmental Heads.

3. **NBA Accreditation Status:** Prof. Pinge NBA Accreditation status of the EXTC and IT department should be shared with external bodies.
4. **AQAR Status:** Prof. Beatrice stated that, AQAR 2020 – 21 has been uploaded and AQAR 2021 – 22 is in process.
5. **Initiatives by IQAC:**
 - a) For conducting workshops, seminars, NAAC provides about a one lakh Grant. Such kind of workshops should be conducted under IQAC. A few seminars were conducted in the current semester. Similarly, few more seminars/ Workshops will be conducted in the AY 23-24.
 - b) Scholarships to the students: Prof. Beatrice said to the principal that a few awareness programs can be conducted for students so that, they know about the scholarship schemes available in our Institute. In response to this, Principal Sir said that, each student must know about the Govt. scholarship schemes available as per AICTE. Information on the various Minority scholarships such as Shahu Maharaj scholarship, Shivaji Maharaj Scholarship, Sambhaji Maharaj Scholarships, etc. are available with Mr. Nitin Nijap from office. College appreciates the students with some prize money for winning various competitions held under IIC, IQAC, Technical societies, etc. However, prize money cannot be considered as scholarships.
 - c) XJET status: Prof. Beatrice updated on the current status of XJET, an online peer reviewed e – journal. She said that, as of now, only four papers are received. Principal Sir said that, to get more manuscripts, several reminders must be sent to the Principals and the Heads of the other academic institutions.
6. **Any Other matter:** Prof Beatrice suggested that Mr. Mahesh Pinge could be called as a Guest Speaker for conducting “Quality Improvement Program” first for the faculty members, then, for the students also. He agreed upon the same suggesting that, such events should be more participatory by involving the in – house faculty members.

The meeting was ended with vote of thanks by Prof Beatrice followed by tea and refreshments for the members present.
