#### ETHICAL HACKING WORKSHOP + CTF

The Ethical Hacking Workshop and Capture the Flag (CTF) Competition was an intensive seven-day intra event organized and designed by Technical Committee of Student Council of XIE to provide participants with in-depth knowledge and hands-on experience in the field of cybersecurity. The event featured Mr. Sean Pereira, a certified expert in Cyber Security and also a eLearn Junior Penetration Tester, as the keynote speaker and instructor. The workshop spanned the first six days, culminating in a thrilling CTF competition on the seventh day, where participants applied their newly acquired skills in a competitive environment.

#### Day 1: Introduction:

- Participants were introduced to the concept of ethical hacking and its importance in cybersecurity.
- They learned about different terminologies in ethical hacking, hacking & its types, hackers and its types.
- Common hacking methodologies and the ethical hacker's toolkit were discussed.
- They learned about the ethical considerations and legal aspects of hacking and the reason one should or shouldn't be ethical hacker.

#### Day 2: Operating Systems & Networking

- The focus shifted to the fundamentals of operating systems (Windows, Linux) and networking.
- Participants gained an understanding of networking concepts like TCP/IP, OSI model, and network protocols.
- Hands-on exercises were conducted to explore network scanning and enumeration techniques.

#### Day 3: Programming/Bash Scripting/SQL

- Participants were introduced to programming languages (Python, Ruby, etc.) relevant to ethical hacking.
- They learned about hacking methodologies including reconnaissance, scanning, gaining access, maintaining access, and covering tracks.
- They also learned about bash scripting fundamentals for automation and task execution.

#### ETHICAL HACKING WORKSHOP + CTF

Day 4: Web App Security, Penetration Testing

- The focus shifted to vulnerabilities in web applications and penetration testing methodologies.
- Common web application vulnerabilities such as SQL injection, XSS, and CSRF were discussed.
- Participants learned about web application security tools like Burp Suite and OWASP ZAP through practical exercises.
- But the major focus of the day was on basics of web.

Day 5 & Day 6: Hacking Techniques & Windows & Linux Privilege Escalation Basics.

- The fifth day delved into advanced techniques such as exploit development and privilege escalation.
- Participants learned about the exploit development process, buffer overflows, and shellcoding.
- Techniques for privilege escalation in Linux system was explored through hands-on exercises.
- Participants delved on virtual machines (such as Academy, blue, etc.) and practised their learnings.

Day 7: Advance Hacking Techniques & CTF

- The final day of the workshop focused on advancing participants' hacking skills through advanced techniques and practical application in a Capture The Flag (CTF) competition.
- The highlight of the day was the Capture The Flag (CTF) competition, where participants applied their knowledge and skills acquired throughout the workshop to solve a series of cybersecurity challenges
